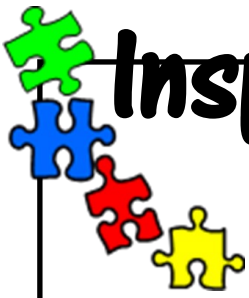


Inspiring the learning journey
