Dear parents and carers,

This term, children will start to receive some of their maths home learning online. This is being provided by MyMaths; a computer-based program that helps teachers to monitor children's learning and provide homework that promotes gradual progress.

Last term your child brought home a personal login for the website which can be accessed on <https://www.mymaths.co.uk/>. Your child will be required to log on to the schools page first by entering:

Username: south6

Password: triangle73

I hope that over the half term, your child explored the website and found some exciting and inspirational activities and videos.

On the day that your child receives homework, your child will be able to login and access their home learning tasks. These will either be an online task, requiring answers to be submitted onto the computer, or will be an activity set by the teacher that needs to be done in a book, or practically. Once it has been completed, the work is automatically marked so that you and your child are able to see their strengths and areas for development. Teachers will also be able to log on and check progress of each individual child and give feedback in school.

Another feature of the MyMaths website is that there are many games and videos that your child is able to access. This will reinforce learning that has taken place in the classroom and allow you child to learn and apply new skills in maths.
