

Human features items on a landscape that have been built by people, such as buildings and roads

Physical features items on a landscape that have occurred naturally, such as mountains and waterfalls

Maps have been used for thousands of years to help people to find their way around unfamiliar areas.

Coordinates are used to pinpoint a specific location on a map and are usually written in brackets. The **coordinates** (156,644) show the position of the bridge on the map above. The first three numbers refer to the position along the **x-axis** of the map, and the second gives the location along the **y-axis**.

Symbols on the map show particular features of the area.

Maps have a **key** that lists the symbols and what each of them represents.
